


# Ohio River Trail West Overall Route Map

## Downtown Cincinnati to Shawnee Lookout Park

The Lawrenceburg / Aurora Trail follows the Ohio River for over 7 miles, connecting Greendale and Lawrenceburg IN to Aurora IN. The western terminus of the ORTW will provide a potential to link this trail with the larger network.

The White Water Trail (future) is currently in the planning phases, and will follow the historic White Water Canal to Metamora IN and points west.

The Great Miami Trail (some existing) will be accessible near Shawnee Lookout and the Village of Cleves. Portions of the GMT are in place today throughout Hamilton and Butler Counties, and extending all the way to Dayton OH.

The Mill Creek Greenway and Lick Run Trail are currently in the planning phases, and portions of the Millcreek Greenway are in place now in Northside and North Fairmount. On street access for this route is also partially in place on Spring Grove Avenue. Work for the Lick Run Greenway is being completed as part of a major sewer infrastructure project.

From the eastern terminus of the ORTW, existing trail and on-road infrastructure provide easy access to Lunken Airport and Otto Armleder Park approximately 12 miles to the east. A new bridge across the Little Miami is under construction now and will provide access to the southern terminus of the Little Miami Trail that extends to Lake Erie today!
